First book by University of New Hampshire MFA Tim Horvath to be released March 5

Buffalo, NY (December 30) – Tim Horvath, a University of New Hampshire MFA recipient, will have his first book released March 5 by Buffalo Small Press sunnyoutside. The novella, titled *Circulation* (ISBN: 978-1-934513-14-9), won the 2006 Prize of the Society for the Study of the Short Story and was a finalist in both *Glimmer Train's* Spring 2005 Short Story Contest for New Writers and the 2007 St. Petersburg Summer Literary Seminars Contest. The title will retail for \$10.

Horvath said of the book: “The story belongs loosely to a genre which, to my knowledge, has no name, yet ought to—the *roman a chose* (the story of a thing), where the story accompanies an object through various sets of hands and situations.” He lives in New Hampshire with his wife and daughter, where he works as a psychiatric counselor and a creative writing instructor, currently at Boston’s Grub Street and, in the spring, Chester College of New England. He is the recipient of the 2006 Raymond Carver Short Story Award and was also awarded a Yaddo residency in the spring of 2008.

The cover was designed by Buffalo’s Rich Kegler, President of P22 Type Foundry and founder of the Western New York Book Arts Collaborative.

Horvath will read in support of the release at the Dire Reading Series (Cambridge, MA), RiverRun Books (Portsmouth, NH), and Four Stories (Boston). Additional readings are currently being scheduled.
